



Copyright Agreement

This letter constitutes the agreement between you, the Contributor,

and the Society of American Foresters, the Publisher, for publication of the following Work, including any accompanying photos, illustrations, graphs, and charts:

The parties agree as follows:

1. The Contributor grants to the Publisher the exclusive right to publish the Work and to sell or license any other rights to the Work held under this Agreement. The rights granted to the Publisher include publication in the *Proceedings*; first and second serialization and syndication; abstract, digest, condensation, and selection; microfilm and microfiche, reprints; audio, video, and electronic renditions; World Wide Web and other interactive formats; translation and foreign language publication. The Publisher shall secure copyright of the Work in the Publisher's name. The duration of this grant shall be for the period of the copyright in the Work and any renewal thereof.
2. If the Work was produced as part of the Contributor's official duties for the United States federal government, the Work is considered to be in the public domain and is not subject to United States copyright protection.
 I am a United States federal government employee, and this Work was created as part of my official government duties.
3. The Contributor warrants that he or she is the author of the Work and has the unimpaired right to convey copyright as granted in this Agreement; that it is original and has not been published before in any form; that it does not infringe upon any copyright, proprietary right, or other right of any kind; that it contains nothing unlawful or injurious; that statements represented as facts or reasonably understood to be facts are true based upon reasonable research for accuracy; and that he or she does not personally hold any interest in any Intellectual Property.
4. If the Work contains any copyrighted materials, including photographs, the Contributor has, at his or her own expense, obtained written permission from the copyright holder and delivered it to the Publisher, with any required credit lines or copyright notices.
5. If the Work was prepared by two or more coauthors, all the obligations of the Contributor under this Agreement shall be the joint obligations of each of them. Furthermore, the Publisher is entitled to rely on _____ as representing the joint decisions of all the coauthors.
6. The Contributor indemnifies and holds the Publisher harmless from all claims, losses, expenses, fees, including any attorneys' fees, costs, and judgments that may be asserted against the Publisher that result from the acts or omissions of the Contributor.
7. The Publisher is not responsible for loss of or damage to the manuscript, disks, photos, graphs, or other property unless the loss or damage was due to the Publisher's negligence, except that the Contributor shall indemnify and hold the Publisher harmless for loss of or damage to original color transparencies, regardless of its cause.
8. The Publisher reserves the right to return the Work and terminate this Agreement. If the Publisher has not published the Work within 18 months of the date of this Agreement, and if, after written notification from the Contributor, the Publisher does not publish it within the succeeding 6 months, all rights shall revert to the Contributor.
9. The Contributor recognizes that the Publisher has and will have information, business affairs, customer lists, copyrights, and other proprietary information (collectively, "Information") that are valuable, special and unique assets, and shall not at any time or in any manner, either directly or indirectly, use any Information for his or her own benefit, or divulge, disclose, or communicate in any manner any Information to any third party without the prior written consent of the Publisher. The Contributor will protect the Information and treat it as strictly confidential. A violation of this paragraph shall be a material violation of this Agreement.
