2011 Graduate Student Research Award

IF you are an SAF member and a graduate student, and if your abstract is selected for an oral presentation at the 2011 Society of American Foresters convention, you may be eligible for competition with other eligible students for a \$500 award.

Eligibility

The competition is open to all graduate students who (1) are members of SAF, (2) were enrolled in a Forestry School accredited by SAF in January and (3) who make a presentation at Honolulu. For example, students submitting entries to the 2011 competition must have been enrolled in a degree program in January of 2011. SAF membership should be effective on or before October 1, 2011. Presentations must report only research done to complete the requirements for a graduate degree.

To participate, prepare your oral presentation and obtain feedback and comments from your major professor and colleagues. Video your presentation (approximately 20 minutes in length). Create an MPG, MOV, or WMV file (you may ask your School's Information Technology person to help record and edit the file). Submit your edited file along with your SAF membership number to: southdb@auburn.edu

Abstract submission deadline is **February 28, 2011**

Video file submission deadline is **October 19, 2011**
